Dear Pine Lakes Leased Land Residents, On behalf of our HOAII Board of Directors, I want to thank all the homeowners who read the last month Whispering Pines and paid their 2022 HOAII membership fees. Most of the \$25.00 fee goes directly to our Legal fund, which at the present time, is deeply appreciated.

Life at Pine Lakes is returning to normal. Our pool is operating fine and we have a new Park Manager, Jason Myers. Our Board has met with Jason on multiple occasions and we are all impressed with his quick understanding of our issues, his immediate action for many of our concerns, and his desire to improve the appearance of Pine Lakes. # RAY STREETER MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT

of Ray Streeter gathered to play a memorial tournament in his honor. Ray, who passed away on April 1, 2021, was a resident of Pine Lakes for almost 18 years, during which time he not only earned Pine Lakes Club Champion honors eleven times, he very willingly and graciously shared his talents, his expertise, and his love for the game of golf.

Prior to his life here at Pine Lakes, Ray was able to turn his golfing talents into a lifelong career. One of the highlights of his career was making his first hole-in-one on hole number 16 at a Senior PGA Tour event, winning him a Cadillac Sedan de Ville. He tagged the car with plates reading "1 on 16", and once the Cadillac was retired the plates were moved to his golf cart.

The "1 on 16" Memorial Scramble was made up of six person teams with each team playing 3 individual two person scrambles. The total of the three individual scores became the final team score. Not quite as complicated as it sounds, 10 teams were able to have some fun, make it through the morning, and post team scores ranging from 179 to 207. The game was interesting and so was the declaration of tournament "winners". The team of Mike Lajiness & Bill Strueve, Dick Loubier & Chuck Yedinak, and Randy Califf & Irene Hinchley took top prize money with their score of 179. Then prize money skipped to the fifth place score of 186 where there was a two-way tie between the team of Randy Allen & Laurie Pellerin, Jeff Penders & Bud Bruns, and Dareld Schick & Carolyn Copley, along with the team of Jim Steinke & George Chittum, Phil Eberhardt & Dick Phillips, and Mike Kimbro & Bill Demoulin. The final prize was given to the 10th place score of 207, played by the team of Jay Nicoson & Rick Hargrave, John Easton & Charlie Matthews, and Larry Guile & Bob Hayter.

### TENNIS COURT IMPROVEMENTS

If you have wandered by the tennis courts lately you may have noticed an upgrade to our seating areas. The installation of the new canopies is now complete. The job started Thursday March 31st with the removal of the old canopies, the sanding and repairs made to the vertical sections of the structures and the painting. On Friday the work continued with the installation of white PVC pipe over the vertical sections of the frame, (as opposed to painting those poles). On Saturday the new canopies were secured to the structures. On Sunday, the finishing touches were done to improve the aesthetics of the structures, specifically putting caps on the ends of the short down pieces of the pipes and removal of the lettering on the PVC pipes.






